Major Duties & Responsibilities

- Performs mechanical work required by Mechanic I.
- Identify various metals and alloys such as mild steel, nickel, copper, aluminum, stainless steel, etc.
- Use of measuring devices and gauges to determine thickness and size of metal.
- Identify basic welding supplies tools, and equipment such as arc welder, oxygen/acetylene torch, welding rods, chipping hammer, etc.
- Maintain stock inventories of welding supplies and materials.
- Use of Arc welder and electrode rods to perform simple tack and bead welds.
- Use of oxygen/acetylene torch for cutting metals.
- Use of grinder and other hand power tools required to grind, bevel, fit metals together, and remove slag.
- Perform welding and cutting of metals in vertical or horizontal positions.
- All welds must be visually acceptable per NBI standards.
- Other duties and responsibilities as assigned.

General Knowledge & Skills

- Basic knowledge of welding procedures, practices, and techniques required to weld and/or fuse metal together.
- Knowledge and ability to use hand and power tools associated with welding, such as chipping hammer, grinder, arc welder, oxygen/acetylene torch, etc. Including setup or connection of hoses, cords, regulators, etc.
- Requires general knowledge of welding techniques and skill in use of hand tools.
- Working knowledge of safety practices and procedures.
- Must be able to meet or exceed all deadlines established.
