The equipment supplied includes one (1) B&W package watertube boiler equipped with an EconoStak economizer, PLC-based combustion control system, and Nationwide Boiler's proven CataStakTM Selective Catalytic Reduction (SCR) system for ultra-low NOx performance. This complete equipment package reinforces Nationwide Boiler's commitment to supporting clean, efficient, and reliable steam production around the globe and on an expedited basis. Nationwide Boiler is currently working through logistics coordination with their local partner, C.Hagay, and the equipment is being prepared to ship from the Port of Houston. Upon arrival, the boiler will be offloaded for truck delivery to the refinery.
